If you are like many of us, you purchase many of the maintenance items from local sources. And you know the price of zincs has gone through the roof....Try USA Zincs at

usazincs.com

Need a new burgee or your boat or tender? Let us know the size you need and we'll get it ordered.

Don't know the correct size for your country when flying the US Flag?

For a sailboat, one-half inch on the fly for each foot of masthead height above the water. For a power boat, five-<u>eighths inch on the fly for every foot of overall length of</u> the craft.

Do you know the proper use of a courtesy flag for a foreign country? When entering a foreign country you are supposed to fly a yellow flag (Quarantine) from the border to the customs dock.

Once cleared by Customs, you fly that country's courtesy flag
When reentering the US you are suppose to remove the foreign courtesy flag!






